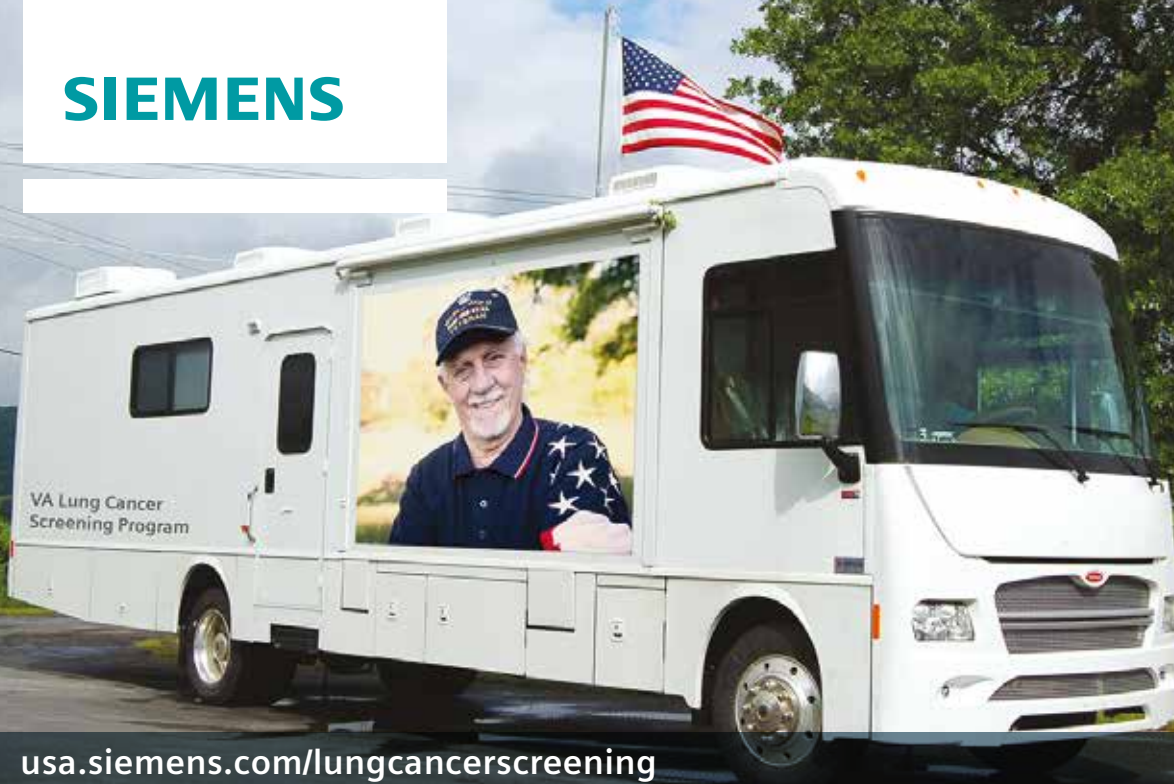

- Veterans who live in rural areas present an additional challenge with a higher smoking rate and a higher mortality rate than their urban counterparts². Providing lung cancer screening closer to their homes, e.g., at VA outpatient facilities and community centers, could increase the likelihood of early detection.
