

How to access MedOne from home

Your institution provides you with access to MedOne, the complete platform for medical reference and education. But you don't have to be on campus to take advantage of MedOne — with these steps, you can access at home, or anywhere!

1. Create a Thieme Account

In order to access MedOne remotely, you must first create a Thieme Account. If creating a Thieme Account for the first time, follow the account creation steps while authenticated on your institution's network so that you are recognized as a legitimate user.

2. Activate Remote Access

Once you have created your Thieme account, log in while on the IP range or recognized network of your organization (e.g., proxy, Shibboleth/Open Athens)

Note: If you are connected to the network of your organization in your Thieme product, you will see your organization's name in the header.

To activate your MedOne remote access, login to your Thieme Account while on your organization's network. Click on "Thieme Account" under your name in the upper right corner. Once inside your Thieme Account, click on the tile that says "Activate Remote Access"

Note: Remote access is valid for 180 days. If you authenticate again within this period, proving your continued affiliation, the remote access will automatically be extended for another 180 days.
