The Deutschlandstipendium at the University of Bayreuth: scholarships awarded for Winter Semester 2026/2027

The University of Bayreuth is awarding a total of 44 scholarships amounting to 300 euros per month for Winter Semester 2026/2027 to support talented students who can be expected to perform outstandingly in their studies or profession or who have already done so.

The basis for the award is the Scholarship Programme Act - StipG of the Federal Government in conjunction with the Scholarship Programme Ordinance (StipV) as well as the University of Bayreuth's guidelines for the award of Deutschlandstipendium scholarships. The central award criterion is special performance and talent. In addition to the applicant's performance to date, particular consideration can be given to personal background, social and family circumstances, social commitment, and awards.

As a rule, funding is granted for two semesters and can be extended within the standard period of study (an application for continued funding is required for the extension). However, other periods are also possible. There is no legal entitlement to the scholarship.

Scholarships are awarded as grants and do not have to be repaid. The prerequisite for funding is enrolment in a programme of study at the University of Bayreuth. The scholarship is income-independent and can be combined with BAföG funding. Double support by other gifted- and performance-related material support of the Begabtenförderwerke is generally excluded (for exceptions see § 4 para 1 StipG).

The following scholarships are available for the period starting on 1 October 2026:

1	Life Sciences (e.g. food and health B.Sc./M.Sc.; food quality and safety; global food, nutrition and health and similar)

The application can only be submitted online. The online application is open

from 8 June to 24 June 2026 under the following link:

The application agreement provided in the online application portal must be observed. Applications not submitted in full and in due form by the deadline will not be considered in the selection procedure.

If the application documents are not written in German or English, an officially certified translation in the German language must be included. Severely disabled applicants with essentially the same aptitude will be given preferential consideration. Applications from women are highly welcome.
