



Dining and Shops

Passengers and visitors will find a varied range of restaurants and shops at Dortmund Airport, both in the public area and after the security check, offering refreshments and snacks as well as a wide range of travel accessories, literature, tobacco products and gift articles.

Flight guests with a valid boarding pass have access to an extensive assortment at duty-free rates at the Heinemann Duty Free-Shop. As a special service, Heinemann Duty Free offers to store the purchases of its customers until their return. The goods already paid for, can then be retrieved at the Duty Free Pick-up-Point (arrivals level) at the Dortmund Airport. In addition, purchases can also be pre-ordered via the Pre-Order-Service online (www.heinemann-dutyfree.com) and retrieved when departing from Dortmund in the Heinemann Duty Free-Shop.



Visitor terrace

From the visitor terrace on the gallery level (level 2) in the terminal, you can perfectly watch what is happening on the airport's apron. Access is free of charge.



Lost & Found

ATM

There are EC ATMs provided by the Dortmunder Volksbank, the Sparkasse Dortmund and the Postbank in the Dortmund Airport terminal (departures and arrivals level). The machines accept EC cards from all banks, together with Eurocards and Visa cards.

Passengers with a disability

Should you require assistance in getting on or off the aeroplane, please already indicate this while booking your flight.

Parking: Passengers with a disability are offered the chance to park for free in the designated spaces in the car parks (P1 and P2) of the Dortmund Airport. The precondition for this is a disabled person's pass with the indication 'aG' (severely walking impaired), 'Bl' (blind), 'H' (helpless) or 'B' (requires constant assistance).

Important: The free exit ticket can only be handed out on the day of return at the ID/Parking Centre (Arrival/Level 0) or at the Information Desk (Departure/Level 1) - the flight ticket must also be presented there. Check-in, baggage drop-off

In the interest of a seamless check-in and punctual departure, it is necessary for you to punctually arrive at the check-in desk of your airline (we suggest 90-120 minutes beforehand). A late arrival may lead to a refusal to transport you. Please inform yourself at your airline regarding the check-in cut-off times.
