Service spectrum



In the field of aircraft maintenance, the company services almost all modern Boeing and Airbus aircraft, while for the moment focusing on various types of Boeing aircraft when it comes to base maintenance. Ameco Beijing offers very competitive turnaround times and highest performance for aircraft heavy maintenance, which covers 737, 747, 767, 777 and A340. Ameco Beijing provides engine overhaul on Rolls-Royce, Pratt & Whitney and CFMI products and offers repair and overhaul services for nearly 10,000 components including landing gears, wheels & brakes, hydraulics, pneumatics, mechanics and avionics/electric systems. Aircraft painting, engineering and training services round off the company's product portfolio.



Ameco Beijing's premises cover an area of over 600,000 square meters. The maintenance facilities mainly comprise 2 separate 4-bay hangars able to accommodate aircraft as large as the A380 and a fully enclosed and two temperaturecontrolled painting hangars, which can meet the requirements for stripping, washing and painting of any aircraft type up to the size of the Boeing 747-400. There are also engine repair/overhaul backshops and an engine test cell, component workshops, avionics & electric workshops, a landing gear overhaul shop and mechanical, pneumatic & hydraulic backshops.

Outlook

The service capacity requirements in Asia are constantly growing, in line with the rapidly expanding volume of air traffic. This is why Ameco Beijing opened the new 4-bay hangar for A380 aircraft and 747 painting hangar in 2008 and 2009.
