## TRAINING PROGRAMME

Commencement Date: September 2025

**Course Content:** This training programme is split into two parts:

- 1. Award in Basic Aviation Maintenance (1 semester)
- 2. Diploma in Aircraft Systems Maintenance (2 semesters)

The first part of the training programme is the Award in Basic Aviation which will provide the basic knowledge and training required to start the Diploma and be able to perform on the job training on the aircraft.

The second part of the training will be the Diploma in Aircraft Systems Maintenance which will incorporate the EASA Part-66 Category A basic course which will allow a candidate to sit for the licence examinations.

With mentoring and practical experience at LTM and MCAST, both of which include combined theoretical and practical sessions. This course can lead to the position of Aircraft Mechanic within 15 months.

Entry Criteria: • SEC/ GCSE Level of Education

AND / OR

• Experience and hands on knowledge working in another technical area.

Selected Candidates will be paid a salary based on the years of experience of the individual in any other trade whilst pursuing their studies. Following the successful completion of the training course, candidates will continue to be employed by the Company.
